Our reading spine is a collection of recommended books which are considered to be essential reads for everyone and based on the five plagues of reading and reflecting diversity. The books in our collection consist of whole-class core texts (Class Novel) and recommended independent reads. They have been carefully selected to stretch vocabulary, expose children to different structures and timeframes, encourage critical and analytical thinking and most importantly to promote a love of reading. This reading spine ensures pupils at Hummersea will leave school having had exposure to wide-ranging, linguistically varied and intellectually inspiring collection of texts. It also ensures an exposure to a range of text types of various genres, gradually building children's stamina and familiarity with challenging texts. It develops the skills they will need to dissect more complex texts at secondary school.
